Goal of the program	The goal of this research-oriented Master's degree program in economic law is to train experts with comprehensive and in-depth theoretical and practical knowledge of economic law as well as appropriate skills, abilities, and personal qualities for professional work according to their training majors, thus responding to the requirements of the labor market and society. The training program also provides the necessary foundation of knowledge and skills so that learners can study and research by themselves or continue to study at higher levels.
Program Learning Outcomes	1. Knowledge PLO1: Able to apply the worldview and philosophical methodology of Marxism-Leninism to solve theoretical and practical problems related to the training major;

PLO2: Able to apply foundational knowledge, especially legal scientific research methods and foreign language skills (equivalent to level 4/6 of the six-level Foreign Language Proficiency Framework for Vietnam) in studying, scientific research, and professional work;

PLO3: Able to apply specialized knowledge, especially in-depth knowledge of commercial law, labour law, land and environment law, financial and banking law among others, and systematic legal thinking to solve theoretical and practical issues related to the training major;

Strategies for teaching, learning, and assessing	<p>1. In terms of teaching methods</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lecturers combine the use of modern teaching methods with the most effective use of supporting means for teaching activities, particularly those related to information technology and multimedia that are appropriate for credit training and CDIO approach method in order to assist students in achieving course learning outcomes and general output standards of the training program; - Emphasize the teaching method of "putting students at the center of the training process" to encourage students' initiative. Lecturers strengthen the role of organizing, guiding, orienting, and controlling learning activities, creative thinking

activities, and skill training for students so that they can master the learning content and actively achieve the program's knowledge, skill, and attitude objectives;

- Strengthen the use of active teaching methods to improve self-discipline in learning, self-study, and self-research capacity; develop creative thinking, and critical thinking; practice practical skills, improve teamwork skills, information-processing skills, and presentation skills for students;

- Enhance extracurricular activities, internships, practicals, lectures, and seminars during the training process to provide students with practical knowledge.

2. In terms of learning methods

- Students need to be active and proactive in the learning process, improve their ability to self-study, self-research, and self-read documents, and work in groups before coming to class;

- Students create their own appropriate learning progress while also changing their learning style that emphasizes discovery and academic passion; learn how to come to understanding; learn how to self-study; learn practical skills and attitudes in the profession; learn the style of independence, creativity, and flexibility in perception and action;

- Students need to actively combine the use of modern information technology devices, as well as enhance their foreign language and computer skills to aid in the learning process.

3. In terms of testing and assessment

- The assessment includes: Assessing students based on input results; Assessing students' learning progress through the output standards of the modules and the training program; Assessing end-of-course/graduation of students;

- Teachers need to use a variety of testing and assessment methods following the module outline for regular, mid-term, and end-of-course assessments. The testing and assessment plans' scope and weight should be explicit and communicated to all interested audiences. The plans' standards must be transparent and consistent throughout the training program.

- The functional units implement appropriate procedures to ensure the testing and assessment plans are valid, trustworthy, and fairly implemented.

4. In terms of the teaching staff and support staff of the training program

- Concentrate on a team of highly qualified and capable lecturers who have been well-trained inside and outside the country and have experience and qualified foreign language to participate in teaching;

- The team of managers, support staff, and administrative staff are capable, professional, devoted, disciplined, and have a high sense of responsibility;

- Well-implement lecturer exchanges with law universities in the region and throughout the world, invite experts and lecturers from national and international research and training institutions to teach the program.

In terms of facilities, teaching and learning equipment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Constantly improve and supplement existing facilities and equipment to suit the high-quality training and research needs of a research university on par with the region's and the world's advanced universities. - Invest in modern and appropriate teaching and learning equipment, and a complete and diverse system of learning resources for lecturers' and students' teaching and learning processes.
<p>Instruction for the Implementation of the Training Program</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The standard master's level training program majoring in Economic Law is applied to candidates who have passed the annual Postgraduate entrance exam of VNU. - Upon admission, students will be introduced to the entire training program at the opening of the course, and will also be directed to register for selected courses. - Academic Affairs Department creates a study plan for the entire course, as well as a list of subjects organized in the correct training program sequence. The school year's study plan is made available through the following channels: VNU (for reporting); Rector of VNU-UL; relevant VNU units; units of VNU-UL; form teachers; students' classes; website of VNU-UL. - Departments assign lecturers to teach according to the school year's study plan and propose exam formats. The format of the exam is determined by the Rector of VNU-UL. - After completing all the modules of the knowledge

	blocks in the training program and successfully defending the graduation theses, students will be granted the Degree of Master in Law, majoring in Economic Law by the President of VNU.
